## Description of activities and learning outcomes

### ACTIVITY 1: Dyeing workshop

In small mixed groups, students discover the different ways of naturally dyeing a tissue with the help of plants and then implement the procedure using a protocol established by the chemistry teacher

Follow a chemistry protocol, discover an eco-sustainable way to treat tissues, work in mixed groups in English and thus integrate a specific vocabulary.

### ACTIVITY 2: Art, cities and eco-citizenship

Enriching exploration of local history and pictorial art by visiting a medieval castle meticulously restored by the renowned 19th-century architect, Viollet-le-Duc famous for his restoration of iconic landmarks such as Notre Dame Cathedral in Paris. Viollet-le-Duc's work on this castle offers a unique window into the past. This visit not only celebrates the artistic and architectural achievements of the 19th century but also serves as an ode to nature, reflecting the deep connection between historical architecture and its natural surroundings.

#### Guided Tour of Bordeaux

Description: Through a guided tour of Bordeaux, discover the city's rich history and architecture, including its vibrant street art, all set in an 18th-century style cityscape. The cultural contributions are of historical, architectural, and social significance, emphasising the representation and role of art over the centuries and its integration into the daily lives of the inhabitants.

### Activities:

Identify key artistic and architectural representations at various sites.

Take targeted photos to document significant examples of art and architecture.

Create personal artistic projects at the end of each visit, illustrating feelings about the effect of climate change on urban life.

## ACTIVITY 3: Visit the Bassin des Lumières and creative workshop

The practice of English to work on the mural will be important and will allow the acquisition of specific vocabulary.

Description: The former German submarine base from World War II, a longstanding point of contention for the people of Bordeaux, has long been a thorn in their side. The decision was made to make it a place of art and exchange, bringing light to its dark past. The visit includes gigantic and immersive projections on the walls, accompanied by music from both well-known and novice composers, centred on changing themes. For this visit, the chosen theme is "The Little Prince" by Antoine de Saint-Exupéry.

### Workshop Activity:

At the end of the visit, students collaborate to create a fresco using textiles they have dyed and recovered objects, inspired by the phrase from the book: "We can only see with the heart, the essential is invisible to the eyes".

### Learning Outcomes:

Historical and cultural knowledge of the location and the literary theme.

Enhanced intercultural dialogue among German, Italian, and French students, addressing a shared painful history: Expectations are on the quality of the exchange between students (German, Italian and French) on a painful theme for the three nations. Europe's place in the reconstruction of fraternal exchanges will be of great interest.

Insight into Europe's role in fostering fraternal exchanges and rebuilding relationships.

Development of English language skills, particularly vocabulary related to the mural project.
